*“Please remember to show the on-duty Range Officer your membership card when signing in; it makes their job much easier.”*

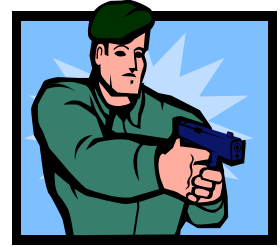
*“Please ALWAYS remain BEHIND the white line and do not handle any firearms during a cease fire.”*

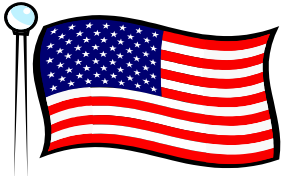
