**The USAR Match**

**June 27<sup>th</sup> 2009**



We at the Golden Spike Buffalo Range would like to introduce a new type of match so that we can use our ARs, AKs, and other military type full/semi auto rifles. We will call it USAR (Ugly and Sinister Assault Rifle) match.

## **Guns**

Any military style rifle capable of firing semi-auto can be used in our USAR match. The rifle must be chambered in its original caliber and be between 22 to 30 caliber. Optical sights or scopes will be allowed, and the rifle may be equipped with a bipod and/or sling. Ammunition may be loaded with soft nosed, hollow point, or Full Metal Jacket bullets. No armor piercing or tracer ammunition will be allowed. This includes SS-109 62gr green tip military ammo, as it has penetrators within the bullet.

## **Equipment**

Allowed equipment will include only those items the soldier would have in the field. Field packs, rucksacks, binoculars, helmets, etc. may be used. A small roll-up mat or tarp, elbow pads, and recoil-shield may also be used for shooting. No coaching will be allowed except the score keeper. No laser range finders, spotting scopes, or high power equipment like shooting gloves or coats will be allowed. **Open bolt indicators are required and must be installed** anytime the shooter is not actually firing or preparing to fire.

The course of fire will be approximately 80-90 shots for score. We recommend bringing at least 120 rounds to the match. Shooting will take place from different shooting locations on the range. Each firing location will have several targets to engage within a fixed time limit. Targets will be of a known size, but will be at unknown distances. The targets will be comprised of various sizes of steel circles, squares, rectangles, and partial man silhouettes.

We would like to encourage shooters to bring your ATVs to ride from shooting point to shooting point.

**Entries are limited to 40 shooters.** The Match will begin **promptly at 9:00** with practice starting as soon as it is light enough to shoot. Fee for the match will be \$40.00 with ribbons for the top three competitors in the match aggregate.

The **Golden Spike Buffalo Range** is adjacent to the Golden Spike National Historic Site in Promontory, Utah. The range can be reached from either I-15 North of Ogden, Utah, or I-84 West of Tremonton, Utah.

To get to the **Golden Spike Buffalo Range**, from I-15 take Exit 365, State Road 83, west to Corinne, then follow the signs to ATK and the Golden Spike National Historic Site. From I-84 take Exit 24, south to Howell Valley and follow the signs to ATK and the GSNHS. Once at the GSNHS turn left on the first service road past the railroad tracks with the "Authorized Vehicles Only" sign. There will also be small white buffalo signs directing you. Turn right up the driveway to the rangers' house, then turn left just past the embankment surrounding the locomotive storage area. Go through the gate and follow the road to the right. Pass through the gate in the next fence and immediately turn left up the trail to the firing line at the top of the first small ridge.
